Subject: Swimming Lessons - Year 4

Dear Parent/Carer(s),

Year 4 classes will be having their swimming lessons twice a week for the Spring term. These lessons will take place at Lewsey Farm Leisure Centre. The children will be walking the short distance both to and from the pool with school staff and the lessons will be provided by qualified swimming instructors. Swimming lessons will commence on **Thursday 8**th **January 2025 and will take place every Thursday and Friday until the end of term.**

Tawny Owl will have lessons on a Thursday and Kestrel class lessons will be on a Friday.

On the above dates your child will need to bring to school their **one-piece** swimming costume or swimming trunks (**no bikinis**) together with a towel. Please remember to put your child's name on all their belongings. The Leisure Centre has informed us that no goggles are permitted and all children with long hair will need a hat and a suitable hair band to tie it back. All earrings must be removed at home before the lesson.

We are asking for a small voluntary contribution of £20.00 in total to help cover some of the costs of hiring the pool, swimming instructors and lifeguards. If you are experiencing financial difficulty, please discuss this with us. Further information concerning assistance available is detailed in BEST's Charging & Remission Policy, which can be found on the academy website or hard copies are available from the academy.

The lessons will form part of the PE lesson each week. The National Curriculum states that: All schools must provide swimming instruction either in key stage 1 or key stage 2. In particular, pupils should be taught to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations
