Breaks and outdoor activities will continue as long as conditions allow, so proper winter clothing is essential.



## nursery & pre-school



Robin Class have had a wonderful 2nd week of exploring The Colour Monster. The children learnt the key vocabulary, sequenced the story, acted as different coloured monsters, and made their own monsters using various materials. The children also enjoyed sensory play with our jars and boxes.

In phonics, they are learning the sound 'a', and in maths, they are exploring positional language. Our Wow Wednesday was a hit with Pudsey Bear band making, and Fun Friday was full of excitement with Pudsey toast, science experiments, and outdoor fun!









## Reception



This week in English, we have been developing our own stories based on We're Going on a Bear Hunt. The children have been so engaged and have begun to caption their own ideas. We have also been celebrating the work of author Michael Rosen through writing poetry and interactive story-telling.

We had a brilliant theatre group come and perform Peter Pan - they were all beaming from ear to ear for the whole performance.

In Maths, we have been working on number writing and consolidating our understanding of 2D shapes.


We discussed the importance of Remembrance Day - the children were very respectful during our 2 minutes silence.

Year 2 have had a wonderful week of learning. In Maths, we have continued our unit on addition and subtraction by exploring number bonds, adding and subtracting one and ten and beginning to add three digit numbers. In English, we have been diving into Little Red Riding Hood. The children have enjoyed describing characters, using similes, practising conjunctions and retelling the story from memory. In Science, we have been investigating microhabitats and learning all about different types of mini beasts. We are also enjoying our Music sessions where we are working hard on our songs for the Christmas Assembly. The children are very excited to keep practising their singing and learning their lines as we get closer to the performance. A big thank you to all parents who attended parents evening this week. It was so lovely to have such positive and meaningful conversations.





What an exciting week it's been! After Monday's fantastic Peter Pan pantomime, creativity has been in full swing. Both Jay classes and Kingfisher have wowed us with their stunning Stonehenge artwork—what masterpieces! And the fun doesn't stop there: next week, get ready for some explosive science as they make volcanoes erupt in class! Meanwhile, Year 3 have kicked off a brand-new Maths adventure, diving into multiplication and division. We can't wait to see all the amazing learning ahead!







Year 4 have been learning about and celebrating Armistice Day. We created our own remembrance poems, observed a two-minute silence, and listened to a special assembly about the importance of remembering. We've also been getting into the Christmas spirit with competitions and play rehearsals, and we loved watching the Peter Pan pantomime! Have hope everyone has a lovely weekend.





This week, the children enjoyed learning about the muchloved author and poet Michael Rosen. They explored his life, his work, and why we celebrate Michael Rosen Day, discovering how his playful use of language has inspired generations of young readers. As part of our study, the children revisited one of his most famous stories, We're Going on a Bear Hunt, engaging with its repeating patterns and imaginative journey. It was a wonderful opportunity for the children to experience Rosen's creativity firsthand and to celebrate the joy of storytelling.
