

Dear Parents and Carers,

This is a friendly reminder that, for safety reasons, jewellery should not be worn at school. The only exception is a single pair of small, plain ear studs, which must be removed or covered for PE. This is the policy for all children.

This policy promotes cohesion in the school and helps to prevent accidents during play and PE, in line with DfE health and safety guidance for schools.

We recognise that this may conflict with some parents' preferences regarding the wearing of religious jewellery and have used the following governmental guidance to make sure that our policy is lawful and does not discriminate against any groups in our community:
