



PE and Sport Premium – School Allocation 2016 / 2017

In 16/17 census we had 289 children on roll and received £9,035 in PE and Sports Premium Funding. We primarily used our premium funding to give all children across Key Stage one and two the opportunity to take part in sports tournaments and competitions with a focus on achieving the Sainsbury's School Games 'Gold' Mark which we were awarded in September 17.

Support Funded through Sport Premium Allocation

We aimed to;

- Give the children the opportunity to take part in competitive sports and competitions including local school tournaments
- Introduce the children to new sports
- Develop the children's understanding of team work

A specialist Sports Coach worked in school mentoring new staff and our sports apprentice.

Teaching staff also attended PE CPD.

We have funded a year of swimming lessons focused on Year 4 children to ensure they are able to swim a specified distance, learn a variety of strokes and life-saving skills.

Organised dance classes and lessons for our Early Years children as well as specific PE lessons using the PE apparatus and new equipment

Replaced the out of date sports/PE equipment

Purchased 2 x new table tennis tables and equipment

Provision of new sport clubs during lunchtime – martial arts & dance

Affiliated 2 x football teams in the Dunstable & District Football League – new goals purchased for artificial pitches

Participation in Sainsbury's School Games tournaments held in Central Beds & County Championships

Impact of Sport Premium Funding

100% of Early Years, KS1 & KS2 had the opportunity to participate in sports, dance and gymnastics

2 x Football teams affiliated in the Dunstable and District Lower School League – Both reaching the cup final and winning.

Sainsbury's School Games Tournaments attended with achievement of the GOLD award at the end of the school year

As well as the above, all children now have more opportunity than they have ever had to take part in sports and physical activity due to provision and maintenance of our artificial grass sports area
